Station Road Closure

National Grid will be upgrading the gas mains supply in Station Road, Oakham, starting on 6 July, and taking about 6 weeks. For the first 1-2 weeks (approx) there will two-way traffic lights from Kilburn Road to Church Street. For the remainder of the time (from about 20 July to 14 August) there will be one-way traffic only from Church Street to Burley Road, and parking will be suspended along that stretch. If you have any queries, please call National Grid on 0800 096 5678. Signposted diversions will be in place on Burley Road southbound via Burley Road, High Street and Church Street, and northbound via Burley Road onto the Bypass, and back into Oakham via Barleythorpe and the Level Crossing.


