COMMENT

Jesus makes his home in Capernaum, home town of Simon Peter and Andrew, and this village becomes his Galilean 'base' for the next three years. Isaiah 9.1–2 predicts this as a place from which mission will spring, and it all starts well, with people abandoning their lives to follow Jesus and welcoming his teaching and healing. The honeymoon period has begun, but there will be tough days ahead too, just as with much ministry today.
