## COMMENT

After telling her 'everything she has ever done', Jesus tells a complete stranger that he is the Messiah, and his disciples arrive only afterwards. They also miss him describing himself as living water, and urge him to eat, a contrast to his spiritual feeding of the Samaritan woman who distributes his teaching, thereby gaining him a warm welcome among her people who believe.
