COMMENT

This healing turns Jewish tradition upside down: sin and blindness are associated, but Jesus breaks that link. The man is not blind for a reason, and he takes his healing at face value when questioned suspiciously by the Pharisees who hold an inquest. Such a healing does not only break physical rules but spiritual ones. Yet the key is spiritual – we are all sinners, but Jesus opens our eyes so we might see salvation.
