COMMENT

Jesus does not arrive in Bethany in time to prevent Lazarus dying. He does not weep because he is sad, but because of the upset Lazarus's death causes his friends whom he loves, for he knows what he will do. In a prefiguring of his own resurrection, he calls Lazarus out. The emotional tension and release is as dramatic as Easter morning, and it inspires both love and hatred among those who are witnesses.
